



## SCHOLARSHIP OPPORTUNITIES

College or university-level students have the opportunity to apply for scholarships from both the Polish Cultural Club of Greater Hartford and the American Council for Polish Culture. Requirements are described below. Please pass this information along to any family members and friends of Polish ancestry who may be interested, and encourage them to apply.

### **JENNIE MARCONI-JAVORSKI SCHOLARSHIP** Sponsored by the Polish Cultural Club of Greater Hartford, Inc.

Since 1987, the Club has had the pleasure of awarding scholarships to deserving students enrolled or accepted for admission in a U.S. college or university in pursuit of a first undergraduate degree. Applicants must be of Polish ancestry and a resident of the State of Connecticut. They may also be sponsored by a current member of the PCCGH, but this is not necessary. Committee Co-Chairs, Florence Langridge and Virginia Pudlo, invite students to consider applying for the 2019 scholarship. ### **THE EYE OF THE EAGLE WŁADYSŁAW MEMORIAL JOURNALISM SCHOLARSHIP FOR 2019** Administered by the American Council for Polish Culture

A \$5,000 award toward college or graduate school tuition and school-related expenses (other than room and board) for students with a clearly demonstrated, defined interest in a career in enterprise journalism in the public interest. ### **SCHOLARSHIP FOR STUDY IN POLAND** Sponsored by the American Council for Polish Culture

Students who are entering their junior or senior year at college or university level are invited to consider applying for summer study at a university of his/her choice in Poland. Winners receive \$2,000.00 toward transportation and tuition expenses. A graduate student who is a citizen of the United States, is of Polish ancestry, and enrolled at an accredited university in the United States where he/she must have completed at least one year of studies at the graduate level, may apply for this scholarship. At least one \$5,000.00 scholarship will be awarded. Prior winners of this award are ineligible.
