

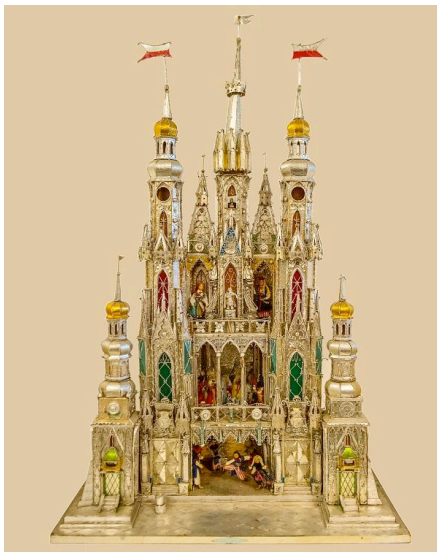

I-91 South, Exit 1 (MLK Blvd. - Downtown New Haven), turn right onto Orange Street, turn right onto George Street, turn right onto State Street, bearing left to enter the Museum parking garage.
